(More..) Consultation on proposed Heathrow Airport expansion. SGCARA households will have received a Consultation document from Heathrow itself. The 28th March Response deadline will have passed before you read this, but the document itself raised questions, eg concern that some questions are phrased in a way that assume agreement to Heathrow expansion, (rather like being asked whether you would prefer brass or chrome taps before you have even opted for a new bathroom....). Response was invited still without real information about possible flight-paths etc. SGCARA tries hard to just present facts and be even-handed, but it is worth noting that our own MP Justine Greening, Zac Goldsmith, the councils of Wandsworth, Richmond, Hammersmith & Fulham, Slough & District, Hillingdon, Windsor and Maidenhead, are all taking a stand against Heathrow expansion. The pro-expansion case appears to be slowly crumbling, eg the substantial air-quality issues, serious questions about the financial viability without huge Government (ie our!) input, including for the required transport infrastructure.
