SGCARA's neighbourhood is blessed by ample green space. However, this is home to a growing number of foxes. Every week on 'Dustbin Day' our streets are littered with the contents of some household bins. You will agree this is unsightly, unhygienic, and pretty awful for people walking the pavements..... To keep our streets clean and dissuade foxes, please make sure you store and dispose of your refuse carefully to help tackle the problem. Refuse sacks should always be left out in a bin with a close-fitting lid. If you don't use a bin, please put out your refuse-sacks on Dustbin Day itself to limit the amount of time it can be preyed on by foxes. Thanks to all those who do this already!

Be also aware of the relevant strict planning rules. If your drive is already paved, how about having some big pots or planters with bee-friendly plants, such as Lavender, Rosemary, Mint, Thyme which will smell gorgeous and keep our precious pollinators happy......

Cycle Quietway

Those of you who receive information emails from Malcolm Grimston will know that a consultation has started for a cycle 'Quietway' running Teddington-Wandsworth and passing through our Ward from Tibbets Corner, along Withycombe Road/Princes Way/Castlecombe Drive/Beaumont Road/Skeena Hill/Girdwood Road, in effect largely following the path of the local 'rat run'. This could be far from 'Quiet' and still not provide the safety intended for cyclists. There would be some worrying changes to road layout as well, eg at the top of Skeena Hill/Girdwood Rd, with possible significant negative effects on parking and safety. Public meetings unfortunately took place at the Keevil Drive Open Door Centre before completion of this newsletter.
