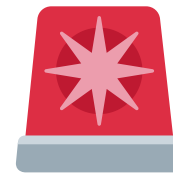
**Jack Strange Creative Writing Workshop**

**AgeUK Digital Inclusion Programme**

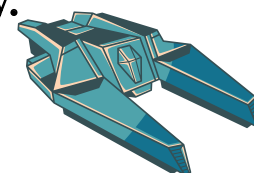
Free IT help drop-in sessions.

June observes Men's Health Week (8<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup>) and we are primed and prepared to supply you with book lists to celebrate it!

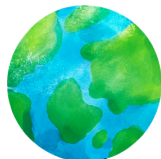
### Wandsworth Refugee Week

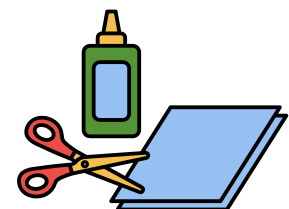
